

SNOW DAY RESCHEDULING/ 23-24 CALENDAR ADJUSTMENT

LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

LAKE WASHINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO.414

AND

LAKE WASHINGTON EDUCATION ASSOCIATION


January 17, 2024 and January 18, 2024, were snow closure dates for the Lake Washington School District. The school calendar provided for one built-in snow make-up day. To make up for the missed day, the changes to the school calendar will be to adjust May 24, 2024, from a LEAP Full Day to a Half Day for students and the second half of the day will be evenly split between building professional learning and Teacher Professional Work time. May 28, 2024, will be adjusted from a possible snow make up day to a full student day.

Given that staff is paid for a 180-day calendar and 8 leap days, the District and the Association have agreed to the following:

- All LWEA Certificated Staff are required to complete 7.5 hours of professional responsibilities beyond the regular workday between the signed date of this Letter of Understanding and June 21, 2024.
- Professional Responsibilities are defined as tasks outlined within the Responsibility Contract.
